- * Extras: (Changes for Tea Light Luminary below); Window Sheets (#114323); Cellophane Bags food approved (4"x6" #102757); Ribbon (½" Striped Satin #127837, Linen Thread #104199); Designer Button (Neutrals #119743); Yogurt Covered Raisins or other White Candy.

* Die Cutting: Big Shot™ & Standard Cutting Pads (#113439); Framelits (Labels Collection #125598); Bigz XL Die (Fancy Favor #115965).

Adhesives:

Glue Dots® (#103683); SNAIL Adhesive® (#104332); Sticky Strip (#104294).



Changes for Tea Light Luminary -

In place of Cellophane Bag, Satin Ribbon & Candy, use: Glassine Bag (from Ghoulish Googlies Designer Kit #126914); Battery Operated Tea Lite (usually available where candles are sold.)
