**Size:** 4-1/4"x5-1/2" (A2)

## Tips & Tricks:

<u>Eyelashes:</u> Punch a 1" circle. Cut in half. Snip 9 or 10 little "lashes" on the curved side being careful not to cut all the way through. You want them to stay attached. Remove every other "lash". Affix to the false eyelashes to the back of the eye with a glue dot.
