Tips & Tricks:

◆ Coloring & Shading: I use Stampin' Write Markers or Classic Ink Refills with Blender Pens to apply multiple colors directly on the stamp. In this case, I also went back over the bottom part of the acorn, applying shading to the stamped image. Why? My acorn didn't stamp solid. This was a "Fix" that worked out for the better. When you have an image that stamps lighter on one side, try "fixing" it with shading. You may like the result better than you think.



♦ Adding Dimension with Color: When sponging the edges, use the same color as your cardstock first. Then, go back and apply a slightly darker color to the points of the leaf only. In this case, I used More Mustard first, then Cajun Craze on the tips.
