

One in a Minion Card

Finished Size 4- $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 6- $\frac{1}{4}$ " approximate.

Supplies

Paper:

- " Card stock
 - Basic Black (#121045) 1 piece $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4- $\frac{1}{4}$ "; and scraps for Eye and Hair
 - Daffodil Delight (#119683) 1 piece 4- $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 11"
 - Island Indigo (#122923) 1 piece 1- $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2"; 1 piece 1- $\frac{1}{2}$ x 4- $\frac{1}{4}$ "; 2 pieces $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2"; 2 pieces $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1- $\frac{1}{2}$ "; and scrap for Eye
 - Whisper White (#100730) Scrap for Eye
- " Glimmer paper (Silver #124005) Scrap for Goggle
- " Window Sheet (#114323) Scrap for Lense

Ink & Color:

- " Chalk Marker (#132133) or White Signo® Pen (#105021)
- " Stampin'Write Marker (Basic Black #100082)

One in a Minion Instructions

Card Base

Score card base at 5-1/2", fold.

Shaping - Manual Cut option. Place Oval Framelit as shown at the top (folded edge) of the card. Trace a rounded corners with a pencil or pen. Use snips to cut on the lines drawn.

Shaping - Big Shot Option. "Thread" folded edge of card base through oval framelit as shown. Be careful to leave part of the folded edge out of the cut area (Figure 4). Place a rubber mat or piece of chipboard behind the card base when building the sandwich. This will give you a stopping point for the Big Shot (Figure 5). Build your sandwich as follows: Standard Platform, closed + Plate + Paper/Framelit/Rubber Mat + Plate. Set aside.

Eye piece.

Punch Glimmer Paper with 1-3/8" circle punch, leaving enough room around the edges to punch with larger circle (Figure 6). Center the 1-3/4" circle punch over the hole in the Glimmer Paper created by the 1-3/8" punch (Figure 7). Punch. This creates the outer ring for the lense piece.

Punch and assemble eye as shown in Figure 8. Highlight with White Sig Pen or Chalk Marker.

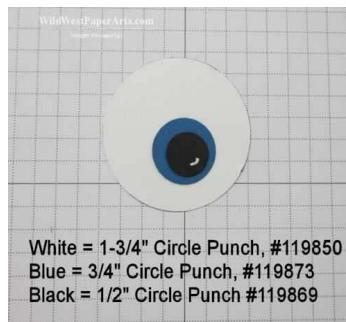

White = 1-3/4" Circle Punch
Blue = 3/4" Circle Punch
Black = 1/2" Circle Punch

Use Glimmer Paper lense ring created above to draw a 1-3/4" circle on Window Sheet. Cut with Snips. I don't recommend using the 1-3/4" circle punch as it doesn't cut through the Window Sheet well. Adhere Window Sheet circle to back of lense ring with glue dots as shown in figures 9 and 10.

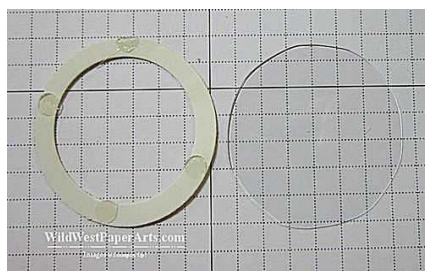

Attach small pieces of Stampin' Dimensionals to back of lense cover. Turn over and attach to eye. See figures 11 and 12.

Attach Basic Black piece ($\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4- $\frac{1}{4}$ "), with SNAIL[®] or other adhesive, to front of card base about 1- $\frac{3}{4}$ " from top. Punch Glimmer Paper with Modern Label Punch. Cut in half and attach over Basic Black Strip. The distance between the two halves is about $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Use the Eye Piece as a guide before attaching. Attach Eye Piece.

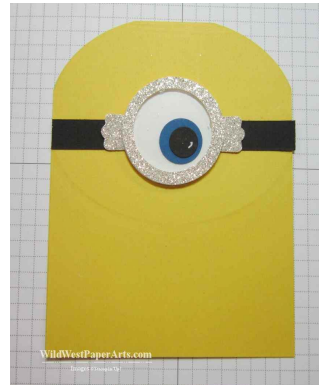

Overalls:

To create front pocket, punch a partial circle from Island Indigo with $\frac{3}{4}$ " Circle Punch. See Figure 15.

Using the Basic Black Stampin' Write Marker, "stitch" Overall pieces as shown in Figure 16. Print an initial on the "pocket" if desired. The letter "G" appears on the original Minion. Draw a short, vertical line on the back piece (this is the longer blue piece) to resemble legs of overalls.

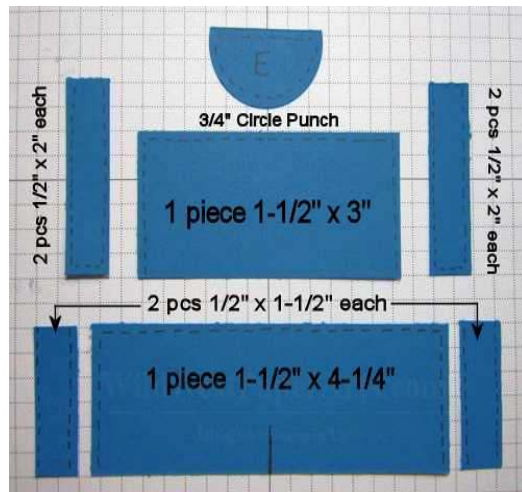

Assemble shoulder straps on front of overalls by piercing a hole through both the front straps and front panel as shown in Figure 17. Secure with brads.

Attach Overalls to front of card as shown.

Trim off excess card stock. Snip 6 or 7 pieces of hair from Basic Black card stock. Attach to top of card with 2-way Glue Pen or similar glue. Draw smile with Basic Black Stampin' Writer.

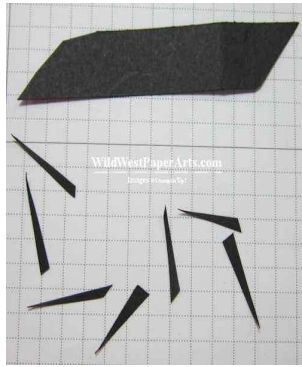

Assemble back of Overalls similar to the front without brads. Attach to back and trim excess card stock. The back will look like Figure 21.
